A) We propose, that Skegness town council, support Skegness partnership`s plans to reskin the council owned trailer, used to promote Skegness by paying 50% of the £750.00 associated cost.

Background:

Skegness town council`s publicity trailer is currently on lease to the Skegness partnership, so that it can be used to promote the town and encourage visitors to come to Skegness, however the skin that wraps around the trailer has begun to look tired, therefore not representing the town as well as it should, it was therefore proposed that the partnership would seek prices in reskinning the trailer, they have therefore sought quotes and received a price of £750.00, Skegness Partnership are therefore looking for financial support from Skegness town council at 50% of the overall cost (£375.00) and as this trailer brings in business into Skegness, we feel this should be supported.

B) We call upon Skegness town council to write to both East Lindsey district council and Lincolnshire County Council, to ask them if they can operate any enforcement on those parking on grassed areas or public property under the council's control.

It has come to our attention that vehicles are being parked on areas of grass and footpaths along not only the seafront, but many other areas throughout the town, causing damage to grassed areas and other public property and we feel that enforcement against this continuing in the future should be taken by the authorities in control of the land.
