Skegness Town Council is permitting funeral directors to sign the burial forms on behalf of the deceased family during the Covid 19 outbreak. This form must be completed by the funeral director every time the burials forms are signed on behalf of the family.

This means that I have told them that there are strict rules about memorials and what is placed in front of the memorial is also controlled. Memorials must be fitted by a qualified and registered Memorial Mason. That the grave will be grassed over and in the future needs to be kept clear to enable the grounds team to maintain it.
