Gibraltar Point foot/cycleway - Phase 1

Work starts on 21st November to carry out footway improvements at Gibraltar Road, Croft.

Lincolnshire County Council will be carrying out improvement works to the existing footway at Gibraltar Point, from Aylmer Avenue to the Visitor Centre. The existing footway has reached the end of its service life and is in need of significant maintenance. The works will involve constructing a 1.5m wide shared foot/cycle facility, with an improved surface, to further encourage use of cycles from Skegness to the Gibraltar Point Nature Reserve, in conjunction with other works that have been carried out on Gibraltar Road.

It is hoped that all the works should be completed within nine weeks (including the Christmas break), weather permitting. The County Council apologises for any inconvenience this may cause.

During the work, there will be sectional footway closures with pedestrians diverted onto Gibraltar Road. A temporary 20mph speed limit will be in force on Gibraltar Road for pedestrian safety.

Highways services in Lincolnshire are delivered through the Lincolnshire County Council Highways Alliance – a long term partnership between the County Council and three private sector partners.
