TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a western part-width of Drummond Road, comprising footway at Skegness in the District of East Lindsey.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by East Lindsey District Council, under reference S/153/01898/19.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Skegness Town Council, Tower Gardens Pavilion, Tower Gardens, Rutland Road, Skegness PE25 2AX in the 28 days commencing on 5 August 2020, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below (quoting NATTRAN/E/S247/4231).

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY (EAST MIDLANDS) (NO.) ORDER 202

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan numbered NATTRAN/EM/S247/4231, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by East Lindsey District Council, under reference S/153/01898/19.
2. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.
3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with section 252(10) of the Act, and may be cited as the Stopping Up of Highway (East Midlands) (No.) Order 202 .

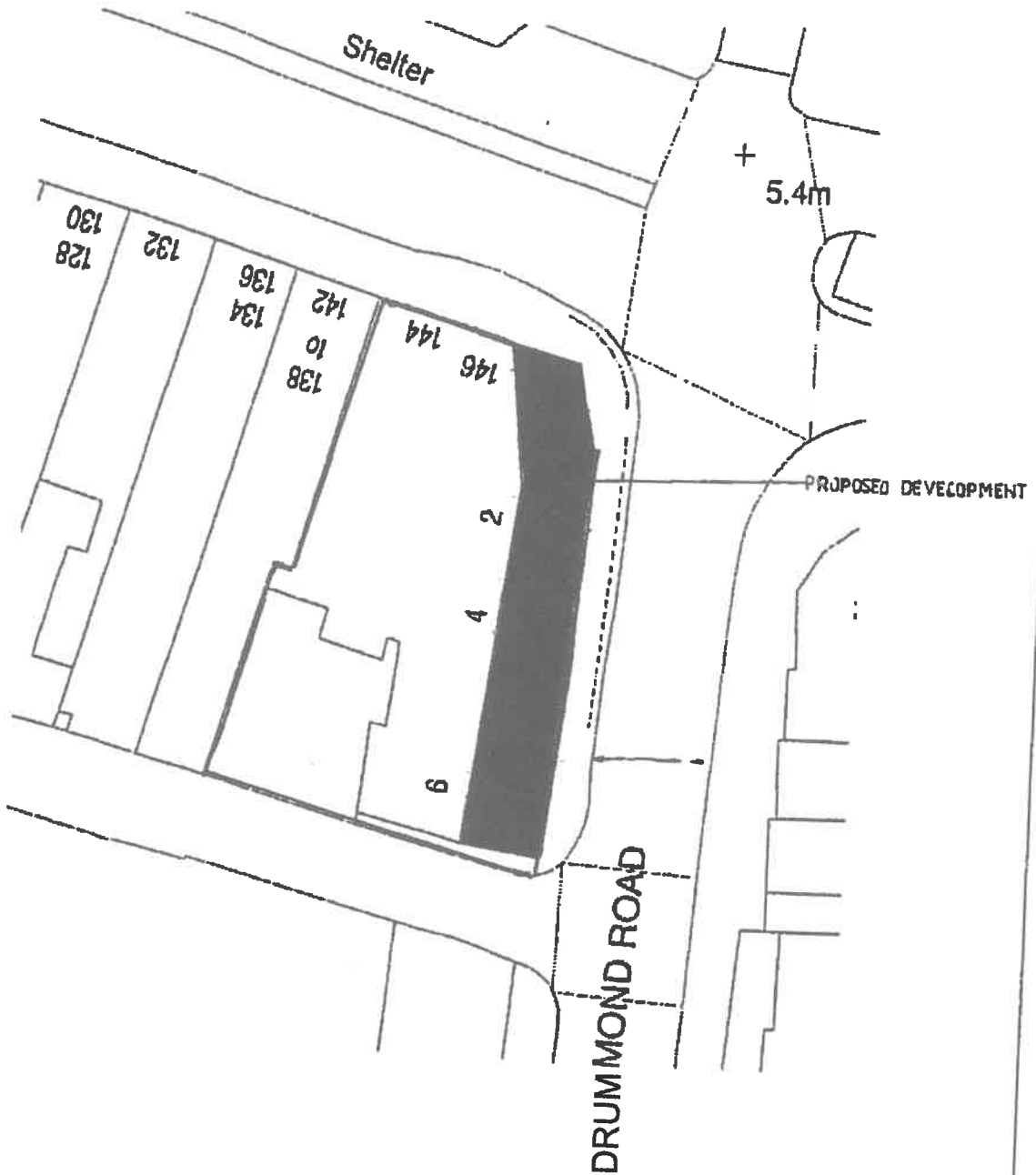

THE SCHEDULE

Description of highway to be stopped up

The highway to be stopped up is at Skegness in the District of East Lindsey, shown on the plan and is a western part-width of Drummond Road, comprising footway. It commences at the south-eastern corner of 6 Drummond Road and extends in a northerly direction for a maximum distance of 38.1 metres. It has a maximum width of 5.85 metres.
